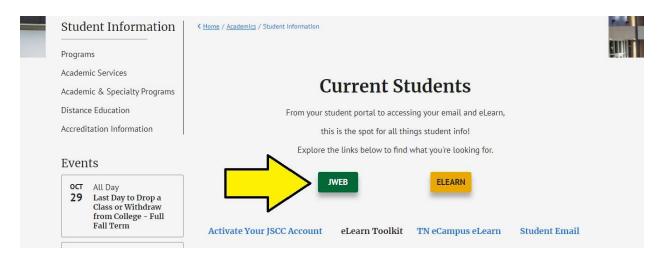
Steps to Register for Classes in the New JWEB, Including Registration with Plans

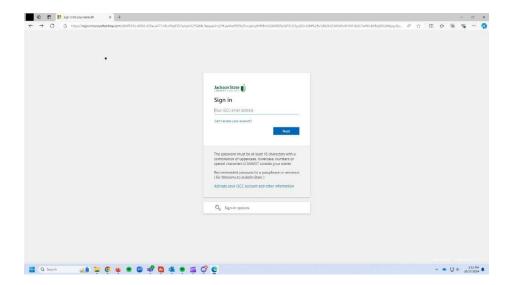
1. Navigate to JWeb in the JSCC website:



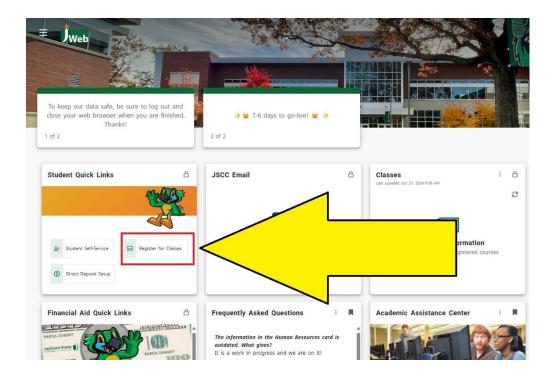
2. Click the Student Link for JWeb



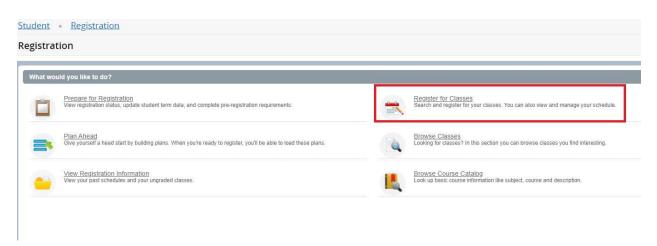
3. Log in using your JSCC email address (it will end with @jscc.edu)



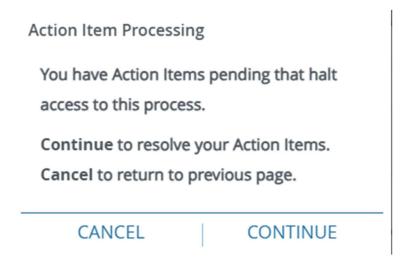
4. Select "Register for classes" by clicking that tool in your JWeb portal



5. Select the option for Registration or Schedule changes



6. You may get a warning for completing one or more "Action Item" steps for our Financial Responsibility Statement:

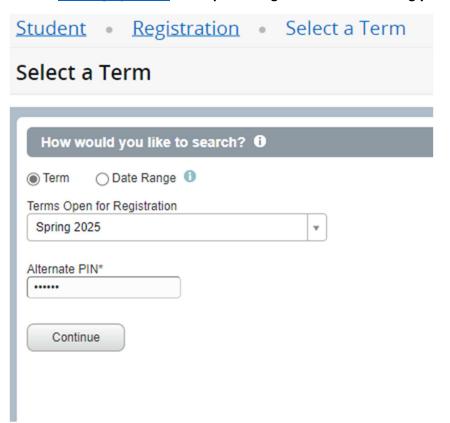


7. Click in the Financial Responsibility box on the left-hand side (1) then scroll through, review, and accept the statement on the right-hand side (2) before clicking "Save" then "Continue" (3) in the top right.

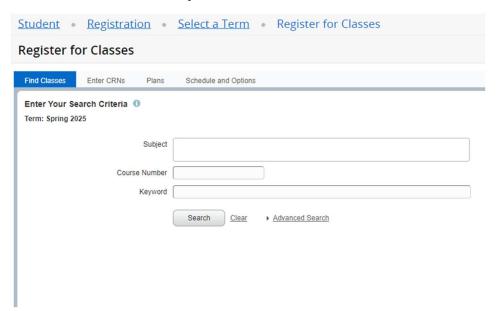


a. Sometimes, there may be an additional statement during some registration periods when multiple semesters are available to register.

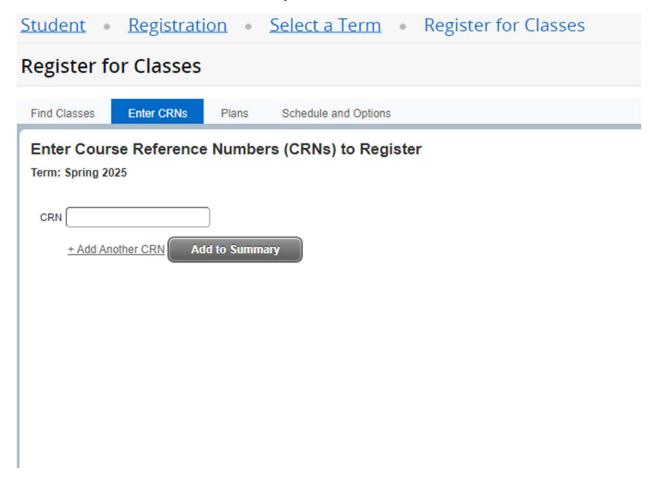
8. Select the Registration term and enter Registration PIN (contact your assigned advisor or advising@jscc.edu for help selecting courses and retrieving your PIN)



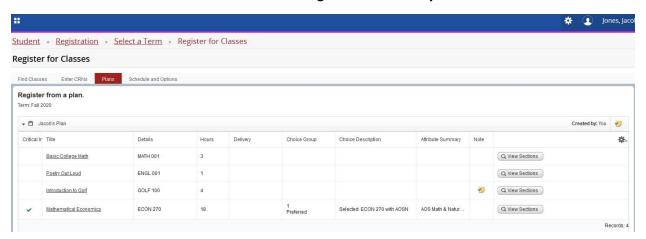
- 9. From here, there are a few ways to add courses to registration summary
 - a. Students can just search for a class to add



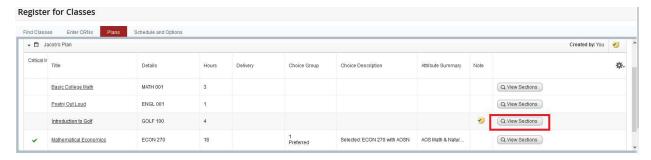
b. Students can add a course by CRN



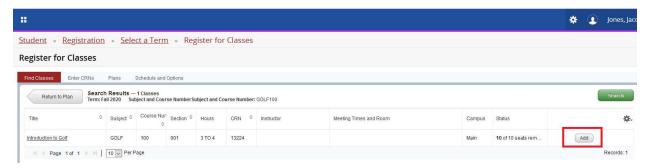
c. Student can use a built DegreeWorks Plan if they have one (must be active and locked) to view classes and add them to registration summary



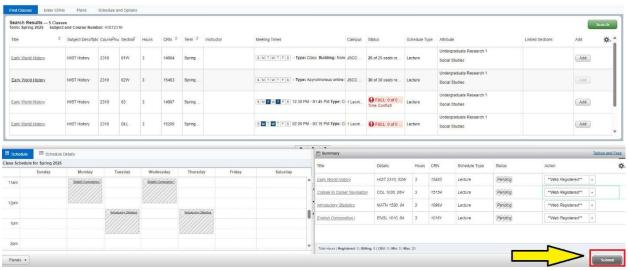
i. Click View Sections to review and select class section options



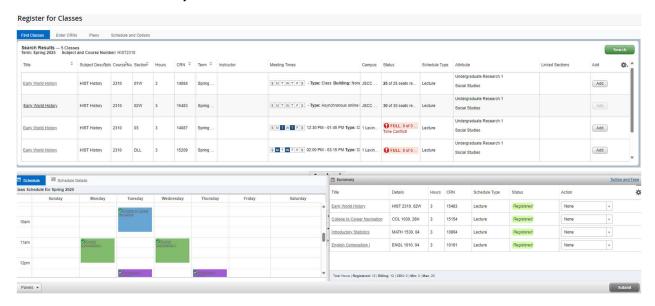
ii. Add Section to add to summary



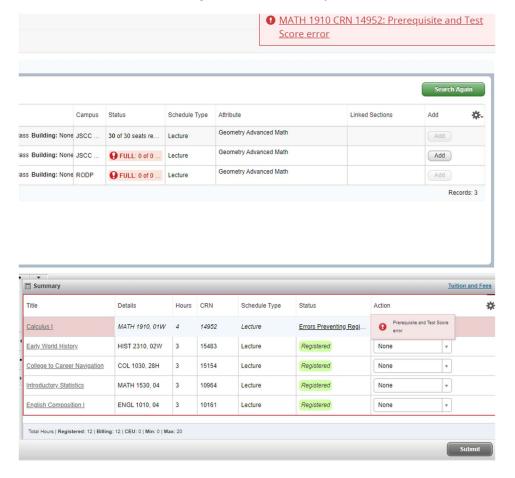
10. Student can see added classes in summary panel in bottom right, hit Submit to add them to schedule



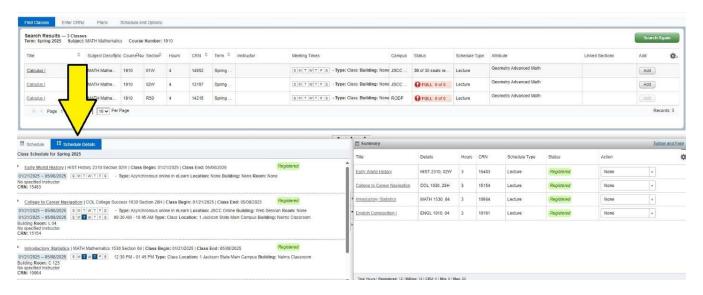
11. Hit submit to register (or other selected actions, such as dropping a class). You'll note that the pending classes turned Green with the "Registered" status and the classes on the schedule are visible in the weekly schedule
