



To set up Multifactor Authentication


- Open a Web Browser
- In the Url bar, type <https://microsoft365.com> (red arrow)
- Click on Sign In (yellow arrow)




- Put in your full email address (ex. username@jsc.edu) (red arrow)
- Click next (yellow arrow)



- Put in the password for your JSCC account (red arrow)
- Click the Sign in button – (yellow arrow)




- Click the next button (yellow arrow)



There are two methods for MFA – Choose which one you are planning to do and install according to the directions for your choice below.

- Authentication by mobile app
- Authentication by phone/text

Option One: AUTHENTICATE BY MOBILE APP



- To set up MFA using the app click the “Download now” link (**Red Arrow**)
- To set up MFA using the text message click the link “I want to use a different method” (**Green Arrow**)



- Click on “Install the app” (Black box)
- A popup of a **QR Scan code** will come on the screen (image below)

Scan the QR code with your Android or iOS mobile device.






